From King's Lynn: Take the A149 towards Hunstanton for approx 13 miles until you reach the second set of traffic lights at Heacham (by the junction for Norfolk Lavender). Turn left at the lights into Lynn Road, Heacham. Follow the road through Heacham village towards North Beach. Past the West Norfolk pub on the right, continue approx 100 yards and turn right into Bankside (before the hill). Cedar Springs entrance is on the right. Cedar Lodge is the first lodge on the left, Alberta Lodge is opposite on the right. Willow Lodge, Holly Lodge and Cherry Lodge are the next properties on the right. Allocated, signed parking spaces outside each property.

Cedar Springs is a quiet family owned park established in 1966. The park is situated in peaceful surroundings a short walk from Heacham beach.

Heacham is an attractive coastal village with amusements, pubs, takeaways and shops all within walking distance.

Heacham is the home of Norfolk Lavender and has historical links to Pocahontas who features on the village sign. Heacham beach is a mixture of pebbles with some sandy stretches and one of the few beaches in Eastern England where the sun sets over the sea making for some absolutely stunning sunsets...

The Royal Estate of Sandringham is 15 minutes away and the popular seaside town of Hunstanton is 3 miles away, within walking distance along the prom. There you will find all the attractions of a Victorian seaside town such as a theatre, Sea Life Centre, leisure centre, fairground, bowling, crazy golf etc... RSPB nature reserves are nearby at Snettisham and Titchwell. Wild Ken Hill is on the outskirts of the village and was a regular host for BBC Spring/Autumn/Winterwatch in recent years.

A car is advisable to explore the lovely countryside and unspoilt beaches of the Norfolk coast. However if you prefer to leave the driving to someone else there are excellent bus routes that run regularly through Heacham and onto the coastal villages and towns along this beautiful coastline.
